Sub: Port Department - Submission of draft DFR for the development of Kollam Port.
Ref: Your letter No. MUM/46/2009-10 dated 24/03/2010.

Please refer to the letter cited above. You are requested to clarify/assess the below mentioned points also among other things and submit the final DFR within a fortnight.

1. Whether the project costing Rs.40 crores in 1st phase for the development at Kollam Port can be carried out by the Government of Kerala without private participation - A SWOT.
2. The hinterland connectivity using backwater and waterways, road/rail connectivity may be included in the DFR with cost.
3. If initial investment is done by Government as per point, above, whether operation to be given on BOT - A SWOT.
4. If 20000 or more DWT vessels need to come what need to be done and costs as the future requirements are larger vessels to reduce cost of transportation.
5. Reducing the time to start second phase - now it 2025.
